Dear Dr. McMillin,

This 1½ year old girl was admitted to Maynard Sinclair on the 14.7.88. You are aware of her past history of generalised seizures and she is slightly developmentally delayed.

On this occasion she had had a pyrexia on the day of admission. She had an unproductive cough and mild inspiratory stridor. There was no history to suggest that she had inhaled a foreign body.

On examination temperature was 37.4°C. There was mild inspiratory stridor. She was not distressed. Chest x-ray showed right upper lobe consolidation.

She was treated with a course of Amoxil and physiotherapy. Her mother was very keen to get her home as soon as possible and she was therefore given advice on physiotherapy and Claire was discharged to complete her course of antibiotics at home on the 16.7.88.

She was subsequently reviewed on the ward on the 20.7.88 when she was improving symptomatically and clinically and the chest x-ray showed resolving consolidation. She has a review appointment with Dr. Major as regards her developmental delay.
