I reviewed Claire at the clinic on 7th April, 1988.

She had no further fits and continues on Epilim 2.75 mls b.d. which is probably a satisfactory dose for her weight but could be increased if she has any further fits. She has made slight progress since her last visit, is crawling a bit better, but she is not really making any attempts at walking or standing on her own. She grips well with both hands, is familiar with everyone and smiles, her tone is generally slightly reduced, she is not making any words yet but plenty of noises and she is sitting satisfactorily. She is rather behind what we would expect at 15 months but we will see her again in two months to see if she is making any further progress towards the walking stage. It may be that we will think of referring her to Dr. Major's Developmental Clinic at some stage in the near future.
