Claire was seen in Out-patients on 24.8.87. She was actually having a convulsion at the time and she had had 6 on that day. They lasted about one minute. She was admitted directly for further assessment.

She was a bit floppy but whether this was due to her fit and she was not as responsive as normally. We did a lumbar puncture which was clear. There was a rather dubious urine and we did an ultrasound scan of her abdomen which showed normal kidneys.

We sent her home on the 30.8.87, no further fits having been observed, but on 2.9.87 she was re-admitted with 4 fits on the day of admission.

I, at that stage, asked Dr Hicks who agreed to admit Claire to Allen Ward Childrens Hospital for further assessment at that time. She had a rather glazed looked. Her tone was rather floppy and it was difficult to assess whether the tone was more decreased on the left. She is rather inclined to hold her left arm pronated.
