Dear Dr. McMillin,

This six month old female infant was admitted from the Clinic for further investigation. Last month she had a febrile convulsion but since then the parents felt that she was having an "unusual turn" almost every day lasting for one to two minutes. They described twitching and staring, and crying episodes. Otherwise the child was well. She was feeding well. There was no family history of epilepsy.

On examination she was healthy. She was not anaemic. General examination did not reveal any abnormalities. She seemed to be making adequate development.

There was a thorough investigation of bloods, urine, ultrasound scan of head, EEG and Wood's light examination. All of these proved normal.

There were a couple of episodes when the child seemed to go into "frozen animation" and then went on normally. It was felt best to follow Claire's progress at Outpatients and she will be reviewed in four weeks' time.
