This Inquest ended on 4th May 2006 with no criticism of the Trust's care of this patient. I will send you a c the read out Verdict when it appears shortly.

I am letting you know that Counsel for Mr Roberts raised some questions which H M Coroner would not allow h put to the medical staff witnesses because he said they would be in the realms of the hospital's complaints procedure.

I spoke to Mr Roberts at the end of the Inquest and advised him that if he still had concerns he should write the Chief Executive. The clinicians would be happy to meet with the family if that would assist, however I wi to warn you that there were questions raised which will properly be answered be the O'Hara Inquiry in due cc and you need to be aware of their interest in discussing policy changes etc arising out of the death of Adam E in 1995. I would counsel you against allowing the Roberts to run their own mini O'Hara Inquiry themselves.
