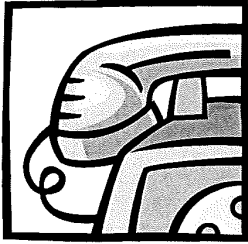

Gary speaking with Dr Webb (Tel No [REDACTED]) on 20th April 2006. Dr Webb confirmed that he has a copy of his deposition and a copy of the independent reports of Dr Bingham and Dr Machonahie together with a report/statement of Professor Young. Dr Webb has not been to an inquest before. I explained the procedures pertaining to inquests. I also emphasised that this inquest is likely to attract a great deal of media attention. The family are legally represented **as** **are** the Trust.

We discussed his involvement. He does have some concerns that the child was not transferred to ICU later and he also thought that the sodium reading of 132 had been taken on the morning of his involvement and not the previous evening. We agreed that I would review his statement further and speak with Counsel and come back to him tomorrow regarding any further issues.
