Dear James,

I am not sure whether, or not, you have forwarded the applicable Coroners legislation to Dr Durkin to allow him to address those issues but, in any event, I attach a copy of section 7 of the 1959 Act which sets out that the medical practitioner shall notify the Coroner "within whose district the body of such deceased person is" of the death (if it needs to be notified). I have tried to make the point in my correspondence that the obligation to report a death would have been on the clinician and, in any event, LC died in the Greater Belfast District and, therefore, the statutory obligation to report was on the Royal Belfast Hospital for Sick Children clinicians. This is a nuance to NI coronial law that I am not sure that Dr Durkin will be aware of and, therefore, you might want to highlight this for him.
