

Addendum report on the Imaging of Adam Strain

Date of Birth 4th August 1991

I have been asked by Bernie Conlon on behalf of the Inquiry into Hyponatraemia related Deaths to provide an addendum clarifying the imaging I have reviewed.

The following chest radiographs were acquired and reviewed:

Chest X-ray dated 27th November 1995 at 1.20pm provided in a digital and hard copy format

Chest X-ray dated 27th November 1995 at 9.30pm provided in a hard copy format only.

I have provided a number of reports in relation to this matter and some confusion has arisen in relation to the digital image.

To clarify my position, any report referring to the digital image refers to the chest radiograph dated 27th November 1995 at 1.20pm.

The chest x-ray dated 27th November 1995 at 1.20pm does not show pulmonary oedema.

Report 4 dated 19TH April 2012 refers to the chest radiograph dated 27th November 1995 at 9.30pm.

The chest x-ray dated 27th November 1995 at 9.30pm shows evidence of pulmonary oedema.

Both radiographs show a right sided central venous catheter in situ with the tip in an unsatisfactory position - directed cranially (towards the head).
