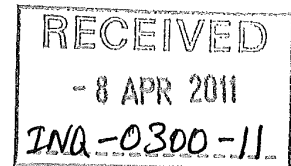

### RE: INQUIRY INTO HYPONATRAEMIA RELATED DEATHS

I refer to the above and to your letter dated 2<sup>nd</sup> February 2011 (AD-0209-11).

The Trust have advised that the Lamtec log book referred to is the log book particular to that particular anaesthetic machine. It is kept permanently in the drawer of the machine. When the new Children's Hospital was built in 1999 all the anaesthetic machines were replaced on moving from the old hospital to the new. The anaesthetic machines were serviceable and were donated for charitable use in Africa. The Lamtec log book will have been in the drawer of the machine when it left the hospital.
