

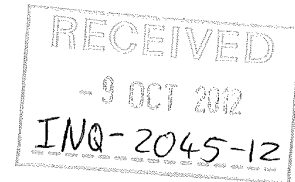

**RE: INQUIRY INTO HYPONATRAEMIA RELATED DEATHS- CLAIRE ROBERTS**

We refer to the above and to your letter dated 28<sup>th</sup> September 2012 in relation to clinics. Using the same numbering as in your aforementioned letter we confirm our client's instructions are as follows:

1. From the Patient Administration System (PAS) the Trust has determined that there were five Out Patients Clinics in the RBHSC on 22<sup>nd</sup> October 1996. These were consultant led clinics as follows:
  - (a) Mr Adams – Paediatric ENT
  - (b) Mr Bailie – Paediatric Surgery
  - (c) Mr Taylor – Paediatric Orthopaedics
  - (d) Dr Craig- Paediatric Cardiology
  - (e) Dr Dempsey – Paediatric Haematology
2. There is no record on PAS of a General Medical Review Clinic on the afternoon of 22<sup>nd</sup> October 2006. The Trust however cannot confirm that all clinics would have been recorded on PAS at this time.

The Trust has also checked the community system LCID (Local Community Information Development System) and confirmed there was a clinic held in Cupar Street led by Dr A McMillan. The Trust however cannot confirm that all clinics would have been recorded on LCID at this time.

3. There is no way of interrogating the PAS system to determine the medical personnel in attendance at the clinics. PAS records the name of the Consultant who leads the clinic only.
