- (1) What exactly was the Trust practice on the destruction of documents? In this regard, the Inquiry requires confirmation as to:
  - (a) whether certain types of documents were retained for longer periods than others and if so, in what circumstances and for what reasons?
  - (b) what "documents" means for these purposes?
- (2) Where were documents stored and who had access to them?
