Since 1997, Prof. Gross has been involved in 5 multicentre, randomized, placebo controlled patient studies as an investigator (YM 087, VPA 985, satavaptan, tolvaptan, bosentan). In a recent study in 2004/2005 ("SALT 2") Professor Gross functioned as the principal investigator for 64 participating centers in North America and Europa. Prof. Gross has recently attended a course in G.C.P. that was given by the local KKS.

Prof. Gross has also participated in the SALTWATER Study between 2005 and 2007.


In May 2009 Prof. Gross retired from his position of Chief of Nephrology in Dresden (Univ.Med. Ctr.) due to his age > 65 and mandatory retirement.
