I refer to the above and to the evidence of Nurse McGrath regarding the operation of a "booking in" system in Althagelvin Hospital at the time of Raychels' treatment and death in June 2001.

I ask your client to give the widest possible interpretation to Nurse McGrath's description of a "booking in book". It may be called something else and I ask that they bear this in mind when conducting their search for documents.
