Hyperdensity is noted in relation to the meninges and there is loss of definition of the basal cisterns in keeping with raised intra-crania! pressure.

The grey white matter differentiates and is preserved.

Following contrast injection there is no interval change

In particular, as requested a sub-dural empyema has been excluded.

have discussed this case with Dr Steven McKinstry, who feels that appearances are more in keeping with cerebral oedema which is highlighting the meninges and normal structures.

A sub-arachnoid haemorrhage is therefore unlikely
