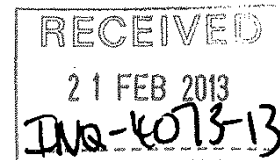

- 2) The Trust is urgently reviewing Sperrin Lakeland files and I will revert to you as regards this part of your request in due course.

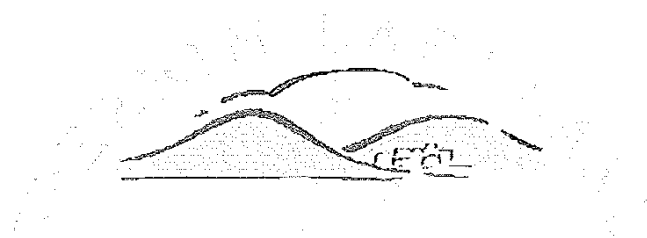

<u>Method</u>	1 st 24 patients admitted to Children's Ward at Erne Hospital with Acute Gastroenteritis from 01/01/2000.
Results	75% patients admitted with non severe dehydration treated with IV Fluids.
Conclusions	Only 25% of patients admitted with non severe dehydration treated with oral rehydration fluid.
Recommendations	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Change of practice in ward staff by education. - Education of parents by leaflet which describes the advantages of ORS. - Change of attitudes of GP by education.

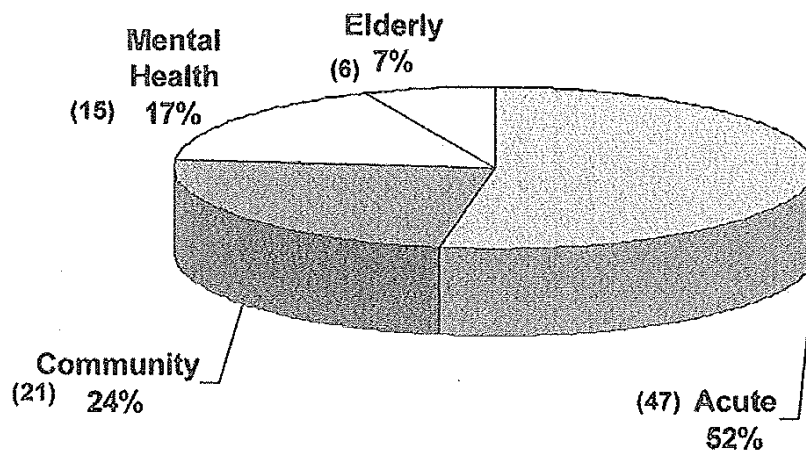
