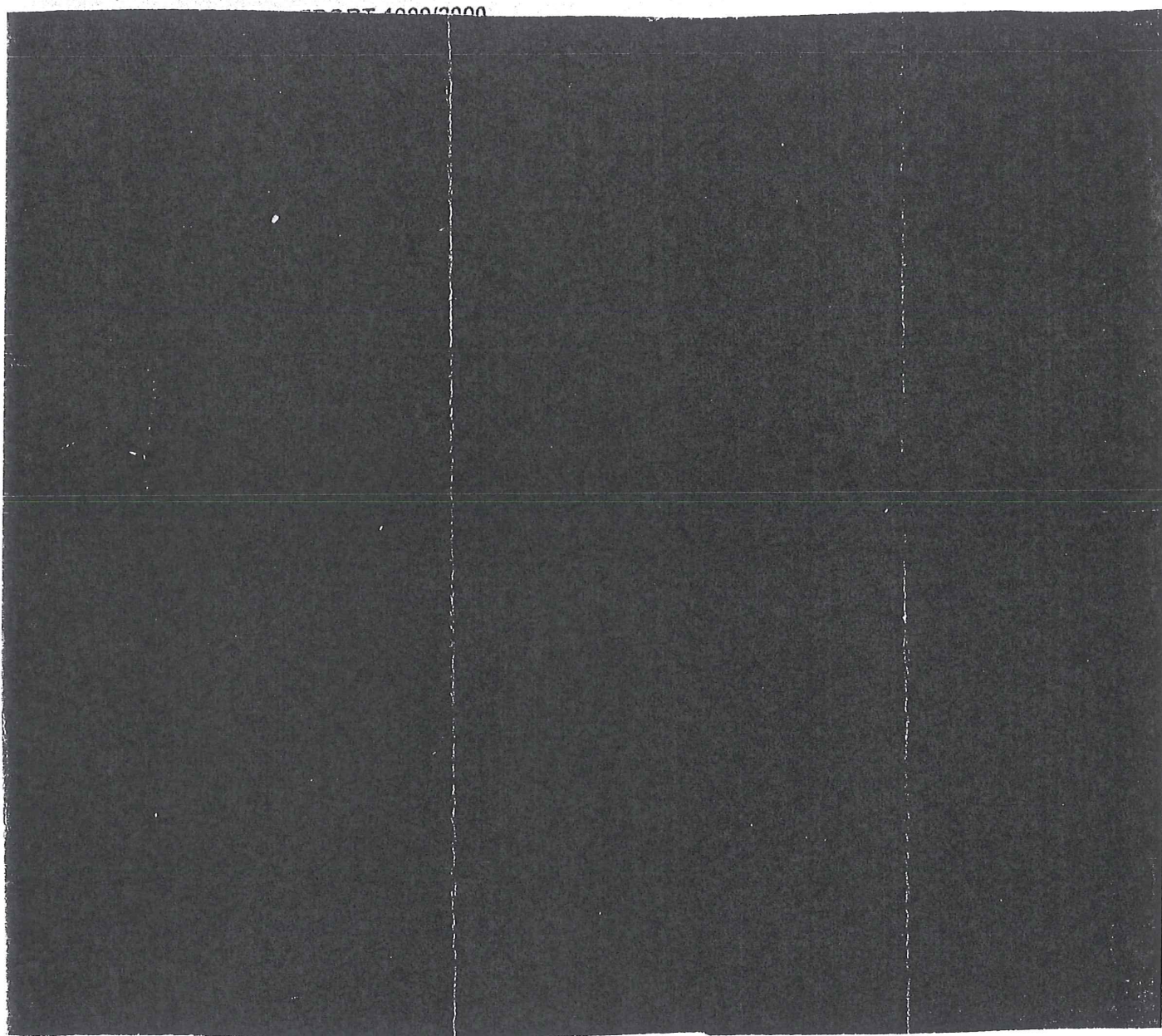

**SMT98/00 : CLINICAL & SOCIAL CARE GOVERNANCE PROPOSAL (REVISIT)**

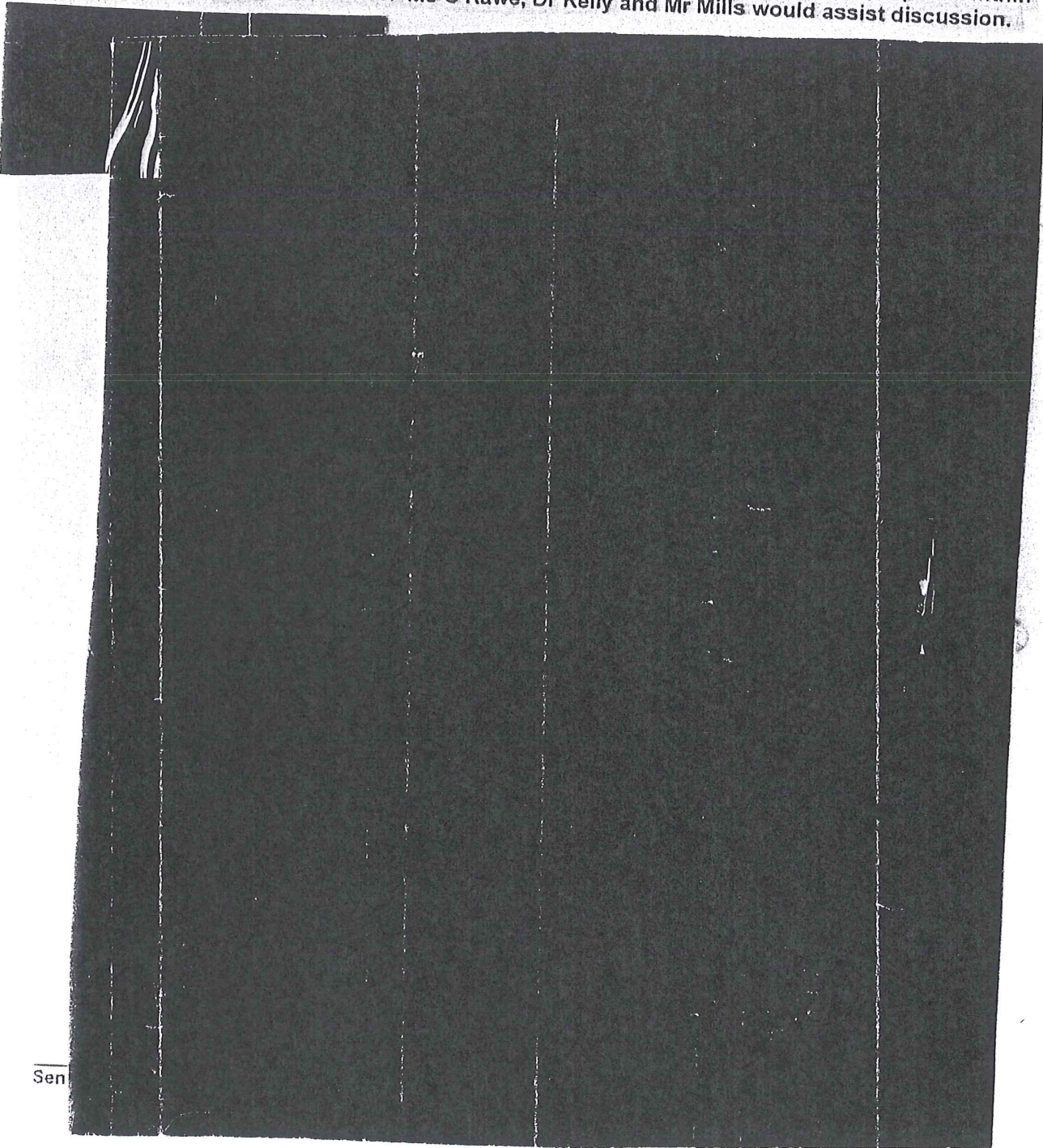
Ms O'Rawe reported that the template for the terms of reference had been agreed and sent via e-mail to directors for comments to her office by Friday 19 May 2000.

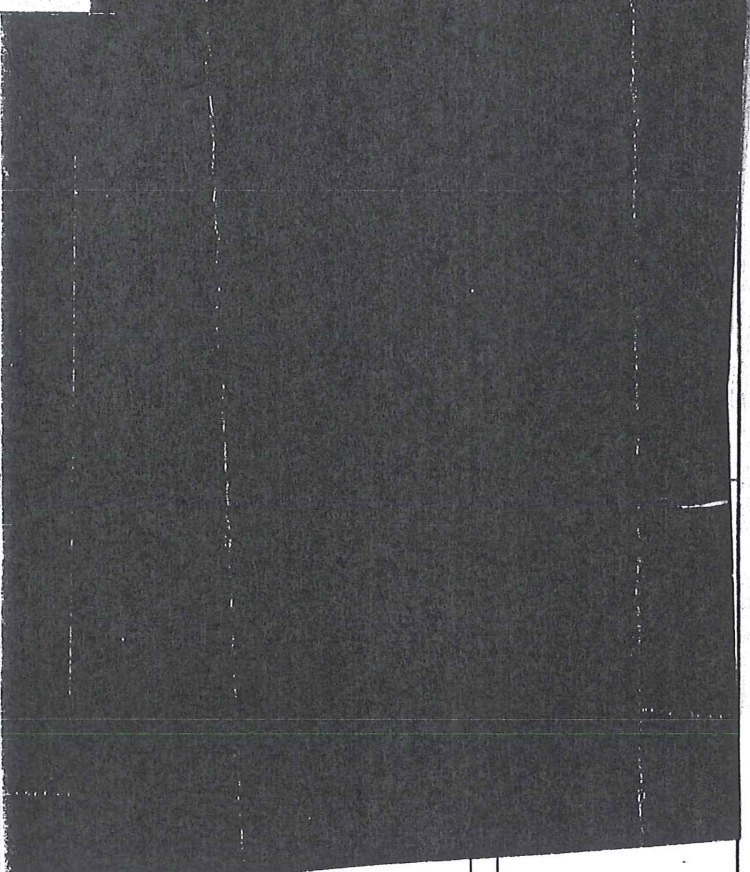
