Can you take instructions on the following matter from your clients the Western Trust and respond to the questions below.

I refer to the Erne Hospital blood chemistry reports 420 and 421 in relation to Lucy Crawford at Ref: 027-012-031 and 027-012-032 (copies attached for ease of reference). There is a time, 20.50, recorded on 420, but no time recorded on 421.

I refer also the PSNI statement of Matthew John Hackett at **Ref: 115-043-001** (also attached for convenience) in which he alludes to the fact that no time is noted on 421 and he goes on to say "I can say that because no time has been recorded, that this sample was manually requested rather than computer requested."(sic).

Arising from this please answer the following:

- 1. What does the time recorded on the chemistry report at Ref: 027-012-031 represent; is it the time the sample is received, the time the blood chemistry report is generated, or some other time, and if so what?
- 2. Why is it that a blood chemistry report that is requested manually does not have a time recorded?
- 3. Is it possible to record the time on a blood chemistry report that is requested manually?
- 4. If it is possible to record the time on a blood chemistry report, why was that not done on report 421?
- 5. How and when were the results of blood chemistry report 421 communicated to the clinicians involved in Lucy's care?

I am Chief Bio Medical Scientist, Technical Head of Haematology, based at the Tyrone County Hospital, Omagh. D/Constable Hall has asked me about a document marked page 32. This refers to blood sample from Lucy Crawford and is dated 13 April 2004. The lab number is 421. There is no time noted on the report. However, I have checked computer records, which show the blood sample request being manually entered by me on our computer system at 3.57. The result was transmitted from the Analysiser system to the computer at 3.25. This is 3.25 winter time. The analysiser transmitter system had not been updated to summertime. The actual time was 4.25. I checked and authorised the result at 4.26. I can say that because no time has been recorded, that this sample was manually requested rather than computer requested. I have handed to D/Constable Hall two computer printouts referring to Lucy Crawford, lab numbers 420 and 421. 420 relates to the blood request at 2050 hours on 12 April 2000, 421 relates to the blood request on 13 April 2000 at 0357 hours.
