

I refer to the above matter and to your letter dated 15<sup>th</sup> May 2013 (reference as quoted above).

Dr Auterson instructs that he did phone RBHSC PICU at 08.30 on 13<sup>th</sup> April 2000 to enquire about Lucy's condition. He does not remember telling Dr McLoughlin the results of the repeat U & E performed during the resuscitation in the Erne Hospital but Dr McLoughlin recorded that she was informed of this and Dr Auterson has no reason to think that this information did not come from him during this telephone conversation.
