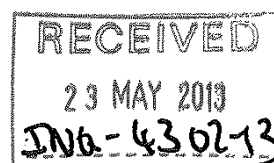

PRELIMINARY (LUCY CRAWFORD AFTERMATH)**


