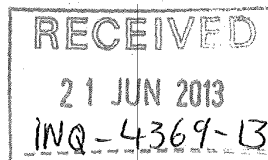

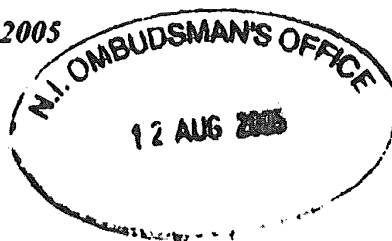

UPDATE ON O'HARA INQUIRY INTO HYPONATRAEMIA DEATHS

You will be aware from media reports in recent days that the PSNI has announced its intention to formally investigate the circumstances surrounding the deaths of Rachel Ferguson and Adam Strain. The Inquiry Team is considering the position and it is possible the Inquiry will be deferred until such time as the police investigation has been completed.

Mr O'Hara has indicated he may well convene a public hearing in late August to ascertain views and representations. I assure you that you will be kept advised of any significant developments as they arise.

I would again remind you that in supporting you to appropriately engage with this Inquiry, my nominated co-ordinator, Mr Seán Coll, is available to you at any time.
