• CMO Report on Organ Retention

Data Retrieval in General Practice

Dr Stewart gave an update on this item. Lead persons from each Board have been identified. Two proposed areas for data retrieval are diabetes and coronary heart disease. Dr McConnell requested that the collection of data should be considered in the context of local health and social care groups. CMO was pleased that diabetes was being considered and that an initiative to improve the quality of diabetes care in primary care would be helpful. A discussion followed on diabetic care. Dr McConnell stated that local models of care could achieve high standards in diabetic care. CREST has undertaken a considerable amount of work in this area. The Eastern Board has an ongoing audit of diabetic care in 75 practices – this has led to an increase in standards. At present there is no National Standard Framework for diabetes. CMO considered that DsPHs have a major role in raising standards in this area.






