Dr Carson updated members on the Donaldson review and reported that representatives from Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland had been invited to attend the Advisory Groups. The Shipman Programme Board is to look at the Shipman Inquiry's recommendations. Concern had been expressed over our lack of involvement in this process. A local process to pick up issues applicable to NI and establish an implementation group, project group and quality assurance group has been agreed. An implementation plan is to be produced.

10. NI REGIONAL REVIEW OF CLINICAL AND SOCIAL CARE AUDIT

A strategic view is required for clinical and governance audit. The main concentration for audit should link to implementation of Best Practice, Best Care. Members were informed that there was important background information in the document. The two main issues were: how to move forward in the short term and the long term strategic direction for clinical audit. Members agreed there was a need to link audit to the regional strategy and provide an authoratative endorsement of national audits. Views on the recommendations should be sent to Dr Carson.
