Clearly the MCA do not consider this
to require them to issue a "Red Alert Warning" on
0.18 NaCl/4% Glucose. I am of the opinion that
Diluted Hyponatraemia is an uncommon and
"unheralded" event in some patients receiving
iv fluids.
