Dr Taylor was not aware of a decision being made in 2001 in clear cut terms to cease the use of solution 18. Solution 18 is still available in certain controlled areas of RBHSC and may be administered if clinically indicated under careful monitoring conditions. Dr Taylor believes the use of solution 18 was restricted by the Trust at some stage but does not know the date when its prescription was restricted. That would be best answered by the Trust.
