To ensure that operational arrangements are in place for improving and monitoring the quality of care within the Directorate To ensure that the Directorate Risk Register reflects all significant risks, in order that these risks can be effectively managed. To ensure Directorate representation at relevant Trust committees by nominating members and establishing reporting mechanisms.
