1 Francis Report – Mid Staffordshire NHS Foundation Trust Public Inquiry

Dr Martin Donnelly outlined the background, format and discussion themes for first item, the Francis Report.

He advised that there would be 3 Groups each looking at 2 of the 5 following discussion themes and providing feedback through a nominated facilitator for each group.

Theme 1 Applying Learning from the patient and client experience

Theme 2 Listening to and learning from the experience of staff including propensity of staff to engage

Theme 3 Communication with patients, clients and families

Theme 4 Maintaining standards, – training and appraisal of staff, performance monitoring of services

Theme 5 Being honest about performance including data quality, recording etc. but mainly about being candid with the ALB Board and the general public




