Dr McAloon you'll recall I contacted you some months ago about a change to the IV Fluid wallchart. This change was made, however the reprinted chart had the wrong title.

I am about to re-order another print run for the chart and have been asked to check another possible change. In the box for the calculation of the 100% maintenance rate, the sign used to show ml/kg/day as equivalency for ml/kg/hour is three parallel lines which I understand means "exact equivalency". It has been suggested that this should actually have been the sign for "approximately equivalent" and instead of a sign, we should insert the word "or" to avoid confusion.

I'd be grateful if you would confirm you are happy with this further (and hopefully final) proposed change.
