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

**Potential risk with 2007 and 2010 versions of the DHSSPS Wall Chart  
– PAEDIATRIC PARENTERAL FLUID THERAPY for CHILDREN &  
YOUNG PERSONS (1 month - 16 years) Initial management guidelines.**

You may be aware that one of the resources to help staff in managing IV fluids in children is a Wall Chart on Paediatric Parenteral Fluid Therapy (1 month – 16 years), which was developed in 2007 and updated in 2010.
