I have been following the oral hearings of this Inquiry very closely. I would like to confirm and clarify a few matters.

#### A. Adam's general condition

- 1. I would like to dispel any notion that Adam suffered from a limp. He fell once while at the zoo. He may have walked with a slight limp for a week or so thereafter. He recovered from this.
- 2. Nor did he have a twitch. He was a perfectly bright and bubbly little boy who loved life and was keen to learn.

## B. Adam's dialysis records

- 1. I wish to confirm that I personally attended to Adam's overnight dialysis prior to the transplant surgery.
- 2. It has been my belief that I did not bring Adam's dialysis notebook to the hospital on the evening before the transplant surgery. However, having again searched in vain for it, I am now prepared to say that I can no longer truly recall what I did.

## C. Giving evidence in the witness box.

- 1. I have never forgotten the ordeal I underwent at Adam's inquest.
- 2. What happened was that I referred to Adam being prescribed sodium bicarbonate as part of his daily feed. I refer to my deposition of 18 June 1996 at page 011-009-028 (typed version on 011-009-029).
- 3. What happened next I have never forgotten because it hurt me deeply. It scarred me. Some of the lawyers laughed at my reference. It affected me deeply.
- 4. For this reason, I do not want to ever go into a witness box again.
