1. Describe your role in the treatment of Raychel Ferguson on the evening of 8th June 2001 to include:

the request you received from nursing staff at 21.15 hour s that night to prescribe valoid for Raychel;

the information given to you by nursing staff in respect of Raychel; and

(iii) any examination of Raychel, conversation with her parents or inquiries made by you before you prescribed/administered valoid at 22.15 hours.

I was working as a Surgical Junior house officer on the night of 8th Tune 2001 at Althagelvin Mospital. I begun working as a Junior house officer in August 2000 at Althagelvin hospital following graduation from Belfast medical school in 2000. I have a very limited recollection of specific events on the

evening/night of 8th June 2001,
I was contacted by a staff noise on ward b (childrens ward) and asked to prescribe/administer an anti-emetic for Raychel Ferguson who had vomited. I noted she was pust approxime Following appendicectomy. I am not sure what time this blesp was at but I feel I went to the ward around lopm approximately, I would have spoken to the staff rurs provide steing Raychel. I would have assisted Raychel and palpated her abdomen, I noted her obsecuations that are recorded on her chart. She did not have a temporature. Her pulse and respiratory Rate were normal. She was not actively vomiting or distristed when I assisted how. I prescribed and administered valoid 25 mg IV at 2215 hours. I cannot recall If I spoke to the Paroits of Raychel, I cannot recall any specific de lails of conversations with the crafter forms.

2. Describe your role in the treatment of Raychel Ferguson from 3.05am when you were asked by

Dr Johnston to assist him with Raychel to include:

with whom on the surgical team you liaised, if anyone; and (ii) tests carried out by you and your conclusions/observations.

I was bloomed by the pardiatric Senior house officer Dr Johnston at 3:19 Am. I know this time to be accurate as I have a record of the pages time. He was blooping me from childrens want where Raychel was and I was adnsed by him that Raychel had had a Sazure. He advised me to take bloods for certain blood tests and an ECG (electrocardingram) and to contact a Senior Surgical ductor to advix him of the service. I annot recall where I was in the hospital at that time. A singleal Junior house officer cover Patients on Several works including patients on the 1st 6th, 7th, 8th and 9th flower I went straight to word 6 (childrens word) and took blood samples for electrolyte profile, magnesium, bone Profile and full blood Count. I believe a staff nurse assisted me when I was taking the blood tests. I also believe I did an ECG (electrocarding nam), I Contacted the Surgical Senior house office after I had taken the bloods /ECG (3:44am) and adused him that Raychel had had a serzure and remained on the ward,

The pardiatric register arrived on the ward (childrens word). The electrolyte public from 330am approximately retrieved showing a Sodium level of 119 (hyponatraconia). She advised me to repeat the electrolyte Proble and a pH level. I how these repeat blood tests (approximately 04:30am). The Pardiatric Register advised me to large the PM blood test sample to SCBU (special care baby writt) to be processed by the pardiatric Senior House officer who was those. (the pH blood test machine was located there). I left hard b to go to SCBU to process the pH blood test at approximately 04:30am and amived back within 10 minutes. The Pardiatric Register remained in ward 6 after 1 with to go to SCBU with the blood test.

When I arrived back in ward 6, Raythel was bransferred to the treatment room and the Anaesthetic Register / Senor houx office was bleeped. The Pardiatric consultant was phoned to come in. From the time Raythel was moved to the treatment Room the paediatric Register and anaesthetic team were carring Ro-Raythel. I cannot recall any specific tasks I was asked to do or events after this time.
