Part time staff nurse since 1987 in paediatric intensive care unit (PICU) (RBHSC):

- Responsible to ward sister.
- Make sure patient care plan adhered to
- Communicate with doctors and nursing staff

I was working in PICU on 23rd October 1996. According to patient notes, I was on duty from 7.45 am until 8.00 pm. However I have no memory of the day.

(a) Whether you were on duty and present in the hospital at all times or

According to patient notes, I was on duty from 7.45 am until 8.00 pm.

(b) Whether you were on call during that period

No.

What contact you had with Claire and her family during that period including where and (c) when that contact occurred

Ref: 090-027-084/085. According to the notes I was Claire's allocated nurse from 7.45am until 6.15pm (time of death). I do not recall any contact or conversations with Claire's parents

(3)Describe what you considered to be your role in relation to, and responsibilities towards, Claire and her family over the period from her attending A&E in RBHSC on 21st October 1996 until 23rd October 1996 when ventilatory support was withdrawn, and in particular:

(a) From Claire's attendance at A&E at RBHSC until her arrival in Allen Ward

I never worked in A&E.

(b) While Claire was in Allen Ward until her admission to PICU

I never worked in Allen Ward.

(c) From admission to PICU until her death

My role was:

- to make Claire as comfortable as possible
- · carry out all treatment ordered by doctors
- reassure her parents and keep them informed of all stages of Claire's treatment
 These would have been my responsibilities for any child in PICU but I do not remember nursing Claire.
- (4) Describe your role, responsibilities and actions in relation to:
 - (a) Claire's fluid administration, monitoring and management

Role:

- To administrate fluids as prescribed by medical staff
- Hourly fluid balance
- Assess the intake and output on a regular basis

Actions: ref 090-027-084

As recorded in nursing notes

- Changed IV fluids as prescribed by doctor
- 200 mls human plasma protein fraction (HPPF) was given followed by 600 mls as prescribed by doctor.
- 150 mls HPPF were given as prescribed by doctor.
- Desmopression (DDAVP) infusion commenced as prescribed by doctor.
 No more detail available as fluid balance charts for PICU are missing.
- (b) The making and recording of observations of Claire including determining the type of and reviewing the frequency of those observations

Role:

- Hourly observations of heart beat, blood pressure, temperature, oxygen saturations, central nervous system and ventilator settings.
- Observe any changes in Claire's condition and report the same.
 Sometimes observations would have been done more frequently depending on condition of patient.

Actions: ref 090-027-084

As recorded on nursing notes

I noted a low temperature and nursed on heating blanket.

- I noted a low blood pressure and gave HPPF as prescribed by doctor. No more detail available as observation charts for PICU are missing.

As recorded on nursing notes

- 200 mls human plasma protein fraction (HPPF) was given followed by 600 mls. Blood pressure fallen again at 2pm. 150 mls HPPF were given. These actions were taken because blood pressure had fallen.
- DDAVP infusion commenced because of urine excess.
- Nursed on heat blanket due to low temperature.

The fluid and observation charts from PICU are missing so I have no further detail.

- (b) State which of them you carried out on the express instructions of a doctor, identifying in each case:
 - (i) the doctor concerned
 - (ii) the instructions they gave you
 - (iii) when they gave them to you
 - 200 mls human plasma protein fraction (HPPF) was given followed by 600 mls. Blood pressure fallen again at 2pm. 150 mls HPPF were given.
 This type of instruction would have been given by a doctor but I have no detail available as fluid balance charts for PICU are missing
 - DDAVP infusion commenced because of urine excess. Drug cardex shows that this was commenced at 11am and authorised by a doctor but the signature is illegible. (090-029-089)
 - Nursed on heat blanket due to low temperature. I cannot remember who instructed this.
- (c) Whether you sought advice from or consulted with any other doctors or nurses prior to taking any of those actions, and if so:

I cannot recall in relation to the nursing forms 090-027-078, 079, 082-085, and 087 for the 23rd October but I have no knowledge in relation to the nursing forms 090-027-080, 081, 086 or 088 from the 22nd October when I was not on duty.

I cannot recall.

These sheets are missing.

It states 5/N Saline.

(c) State the reasons why the IV fluids were changed in this way at that time and identify the person/s who decided to change the fluids.

I cannot check this as charts are missing.

(22) "Dr. Webb/Dr. Steen have discussed Claire's clinical condition with her parents." (Ref: 090-022-060)

Explained to [Claire's] parents that Claire's brain had swollen... Parents...Asked why her brain had swollen. It was explained it was probably caused by a virus." (Ref: 090-028-088)
